

Alberta Seed Processors Announce Annual General Meeting

November 2, 2020 – Lacombe, AB - Alberta Seed Processors (ASP) announced today that it will launch an on-line format for their Annual General Meeting. The meeting is scheduled for January 15, 2021.

At a recent board of directors meeting, the ASP board made the difficult decision to alter the historical in-person Annual General Meeting that has been a hallmark of the Association's membership engagement. "Our AGM has always been an event to look forward to", says Tom Coppock, President of Alberta Seed Processors. "Seed plant staff, former board of directors, and suppliers have marked the second week of January on their calendars as a 'can't miss' event for decades."

For the past 67 years, Alberta Seed Processors have hosted an AGM that provides a backdrop for membership engagement, association oversight, and connecting members with suppliers. Due to the uncertain nature of public gathering rulings, the board made the difficult decision to stray from the historical event format and to host the event online.

"We are hoping that we may get folks that found it impossible to attend our AGM, to join us on January 15, 2021 at our virtual event. The cool thing about many of the online meeting platforms is that you can attend any meetings without having to navigate winter driving conditions". Consideration is also going into hosting ancillary virtual networking & education events prior to, and after the official AGM.
