

Alberta Seed Processors Announce Election Results, and Establish Executive For 2026

The Alberta Seed Processors' (ASP) provincial board of directors announce the results of the regional elections for region 3 (eastern Alberta), region 5 (North east Alberta), region 6 (north west Alberta), and region 7 (peace country of Alberta & BC) that were held in conjunction with the AGM in January 2026.

The region 3 election acclaimed Ryan Kuefler to represent region 3 for a 2-year term. Louis Dechaine, the incumbent from region 5 was re-elected for a 3-year term: Uwe Quedenbaum of Barrhead was re-elected as director for region 6. The election for director in region 7 resulted in the re-election of Mike Head.

Further, the Alberta Seed Processors' Manager's Association has appointed Tom Luethi (Warburg) and Greg Andrews (Three Hills) as representatives on the provincial board

In other organizational news, Uwe Quedenbaum has been elected President and Chad Kanngiesser has been elected Vice-President of ASP.
